This has been an amazing 30 year journey, creating a business in Skipton I'm proud of.

Starting at the age of 27, I began to create Herriots. Known as the Midland Hotel previously, I closed the business and embarked on a major refurbishment programme. All bedrooms needed to be made en-suite, the ground floor was

reconfigured with a new bar dining area and the kitchen updated. Money and time was tight, so to keep costs down, the building team lived in the hotel 5 days a week and I cooked breakfast and evening meals for them, enabling them to continue to work late into the evening. For the first 6 years I managed the hotel myself after which, I passed the reins onto Susan Fairclough (now Wilkinson) who still works with me on sales and marketing. Chris, the General Manager now, I spotted early in his career some 11 years ago and I am delighted to work with him and his team as we continue to drive forward.

Building upon this base, I extended the hotel and redeveloped the derelict outbuildings to give us more rooms and a large function suite and conservatory, always working within the team ethos of "aiming to exceed guest expectations".

Over the years we have had the privilege of looking after 3 generations of many families, with weddings, anniversaries, birthdays, christenings and also as guests in our restaurant and bar. It always gives me immense pleasure when I read reviews of how lovely all the team are and what wonderful food they have had.
